Edinburgh Tram Network Planning Prior Approvals Shandwick Place

I refer to the above and your letter of 1 July and my letter of 11 July.

Shandwick Place (Batch 1/17)

I confirm that Infraco has been instructed to relocate the tram stop to allow sufficient space for a controlled, staggered pedestrian crossing whilst minimising the visual impact to the listed Gladstone statue. In addition, instructions have been issued to retain the tram control cabinet on the south side of the crossent and that proposed lighting should be positioned around the gardens as per existing arrangements to minimise any adverse visual impact to the listed properties.

tie are currently evaluating any entitlement that Infraco (SDS) may have regarding recovery of time or costs and I will confirm the outcome in the next few weeks.

Murrayfield Tramstop (5/06) and Murrayfield Retaining Wall (5/07)

I confirm that Infraco have been instructed to incorporate the latest requirements from Lothian and Borders Police. In addition, the requirement to introduce a visual pattern into the blockwerk to "breakdown" the visual impact of the structure has also been instructed.

tie are currently evaluating any entitlement that Infraco may have regarding recovery of time or costs as a result of these instructions.
