Richard,

I attach an information request from our solicitors Shepherd and Wedderburn. As you will appreciate, in order to form their independent view of the validity of the RTNs and grounds for termination, our solicitors/counsel will need to understand the extent to which there is an evidential basis for each of the alleged Infraco defaults. The attached list sets out the information required.

We should stress that the purpose of the information request is not to attempt an analysis of the matters of fact which are at issue between tie and Infraco - CEC will rely on tie in this regard. Instead, we wish to ensure that our advisors can give us a meaningful opinion on the grounds for termination against the background of the relevant facts and circumstances, rather than simply providing a theoretical legal view on the operation of the termination provisions of the Infraco contract.

Could I ask you to arrange for the requested information to be provided as soon as possible and in any event **by close of business on Friday 22 October**. It would be helpful if tie could cross-refer to each of the numbered items on the list and if the requested information or evidence does not exist for a particular numbered item please state "None".

If this timescale is likely to present any difficulty could you let me know?
