- 1. - 3. I have included the 18th Feb letter from **tie** to BSC on defamation; we still need the dates for the programme rejections and the two recent Haymarket letters
- 4. I have stuck with a <u>seven day reply</u> period; I am not wedded to this but longer gives the appearance that **tie** are not that bothered (Tony, I think favours a longer time).
