Alan,

Any change in view about how we now in see the BDDI-IFC in aggregate applying what we have learned from the first adjudications is very much part of the Pitchfork workstreams. To date we have adjudicated or agreed items totalling £3m in the Dec 09 QS view which as you know had a total BDDI-IFC value/exposure per QS view of £21m. The adjudications do not increase or decrease our cost exposure on these items in aggregate.

We have a further 3 BDDI-IFC items going into DRP today with an aggregate QS view value of £4.5m and a further 3 items next week with an aggregate QS view value of £2.3m.
