Infraco Contract – Access to BIW Document Control System**

We refer to your letter no INF CORR 3161/TG dated 13th January 2010. We note your reference to discussion with our Stefan Rotthaus, but confirm that we did not intent to suggest that access to our BIW Document Control system would be made available outside the members of the Consortium and our designers.

We do intend to establish another 'project' with BIW which will contain reference copies of the components of all assurance and handover documentation and will be happy to make read-only access available to tie, TEL, CEC etc. It is our hope that this database will be acceptable to the eventual users as the long term repository for all project documentation and the software operating licence can be transferred at project completion. Obviously this will only happen if the system is approved for such used by tie etc.
