**Edinburgh Tram Project
Traffic Regulation Design Update Exhibitions**

Works to construct the tram network infrastructure begin later this month and the tram is scheduled to open to passengers in 2011. As a consequence, new Traffic Regulation Order measures (TRO's) will be needed to enable the tram to operate efficiently on the road network in 2011.

The design of the new TRO measures follows on from the completion of the detailed design of the tram system. The TRO draft details are at an advanced stage and should be completed by the end of the year. However, we feel that these are now of a sufficient level of detail to permit a meaningful exhibition to inform organisations and members of the public of the TRO proposals.

We would like to share this information with the public at a series of public exhibitions to be held from late September to mid-October and a schedule showing dates and venues can be seen on the reverse of this letter. Each exhibition will deal with a particular section of the tram route (*as detailed under the column headed "Tram Route Section"*). There will be an opportunity for you to see the drawings, discuss any queries with members of the Project Team and record any comments which you may have at this stage. These comments will be considered and as far as is possible, incorporated in the finalisation of the design. It should be noted that these design exhibitions do not form part of the formal statutory TRO process, which is not due to commence until the Spring of 2009.

We hope that you will take this opportunity to attend and look forward to seeing you at one of the exhibitions.
