Utility Diversions - Leith Walk


From the end of April 2008 the main utility diversion programme will be completed on Leith Walk. Details are listed in the table below and a map of the colour coded areas can be viewed overleaf.

There will be additional works requiring traffic management following the programme above. These include the installation of utility crossings and the abandonment of utility apparatus, which conflicts with the tram alignment. The traffic management arrangements required for these remaining works will be localised and much smaller than presently seen on Leith Walk.

The utility crossings are planned to be carried out by installing a one way system on Leith Walk, with traffic flowing southbound on Leith Walk and making the return northbound journey via Easter Road. The one way system is to commence once Duke Street is returned to two way flow in early July.

Edinburgh's businesses will remain open and accessible and welcome your continued patronage.

You can access specific bus information by visiting www.lothianbuses.com or your local operator's website. Taxis can also use the diversion routes highlighted and taxi stance locations will remain unaffected.

Motorists

Drivers travelling on Leith Walk should follow the signed diversion routes to their destination. There will be a number of temporary parking restrictions in place, which will be signposted. We would ask all drivers to assist us in keeping the city centre roads clear and to keep Edinburgh moving.

Shoppers / Tourists

Throughout the works Leith Walk will continue to be open for shoppers and tourists. Any changes to access will be clearly signposted. For your safety we would ask that all pedestrians use the clearly signed pedestrian routes around the work sites.

Cyclists

We are in close dialogue with Spokes to agree any future amendments to cycling routes during construction. In the interim, cyclists should follow the appropriate traffic diversions. For more information, visit www.spokes.org.uk.
