




Ocean Terminal to Port of Leith






Port of Leith to Bernard Street






Bernard Street to Foot of the Walk



Foot of the Walk to Balfour Street




Balfour Street to McDonald Road





McDonald Road to Picardy Place








St Andrew Square to Princes Street West






Princes Street West to Shandwick Place Trams




Shandwick Place to Haymarket









The Impact?


- Leith Walk

 - Closure to traffic only
 - Diversion of buses along George Street
- Shandwick Place
 - Closure to traffic only
