5.0	Pricing Process BBS requested clarification. tie stated that all new prices would be consolidated into bid during early December in order to confirm the £498m project budget to council on 20th December. Includes: Provisional quantity prices: ES Schedule presented with various dates based on 10 day turn around for firm prices to be submitted from BBS to tie on items where quantities were provisional. Confirmatory response awaited on dates awaited from BBS VE price reduction Across the entire project, these would follow conclusion of all technical discussions and need to be owned and included in any BBS repricing. BBS also stated that they received uncontrolled pricing or measurement information that in many cases does not match the information contained in the data room. tie advised:
