Subject: DLA Letter, tie Infraco report and risk matrix.

Andrew, the version of the letter attached was received at 11.20 today from Leo Hughes.

- 1. As discussed, I have suggested some wording changes and highlighted areas where updating may or is needed, either because events are moving or because we would like different language. Some comments and queries are also noted.
- 2. In addition to the above, we require to form a collective view, supported by your letter, on the defences against procurement challenge.
- 3. Stewart is looking at linkage from risks described in the letter to the risk matrix and on to the QRA and our budget. He may have further comments.
- 4. I also attach tie's revised Infraco commentary, received today from you at 14.39 with some amendments. The main letter will need to provide a view on the legal content of the tie Infraco commentary.

The tie Infraco doc is in need of work on two areas :

- * Comment on the "holy trinity" documents and the alignment work and outstanding exposure. Steven can you advise who would be best to summarise this?
- * The Tramco section needs sorted out and the bond issue raised by CEC today reflected. Could Stewart / Dennis tackle this please.

Tie will take responsibility to execute a final form of this for your review and comment.

The DLA letter and the annexes are central to CEC's comfort level and we do need to spend some time on these points and then discuss acceptable outcomes with Gill. We've pencilled in half an hour after the TPB tomorrow, probably around 11.30.
