- 1. Draft report to be available tonight
- 2. Infraco
  - is critical in terms of time, VfM, Budget
  - time of concern between now and financial close hence vital that due diligence process is closed out
- 3. Out comes of due diligence and Risk transfer may or may not be met-

Action: Micro management through planned delivery and close out of all issues by deadline

- 4. Management Controls
  - Tram Director must be empowered
  - Chair and Board must support not hinder progress
- 5. Contract Management
  - Change of structure and staff proposed within tie
- 6. Stakeholder Support
  - £500m confirmed
  - Funding for 1a and 1b
  - Letter from TS expected within 7 days

Action: meeting of Directors to confirm terms of grant award and will require letter of comfort to bidders

- 7. Delivery of Strategy
  - Reduction of TSS role with more of a role for tie
  - Co-location of CEC staff assisting with planning process
  - Governance- clear role now for CEC, with TS only acting as a funder

Action: Define Governance within tie and CEC with clear lines for decision making and simplicity thus avoiding duplication or unnecessary delay.

- 8. Adequacy of Plans
  - Risk recording rather than management
  - Risk to CEC rather than project
  - Risk to be addressed specifically by TPB and not embedded into other agenda topics
- 9. Other Matters
  - OGC to prepare costed risk assessment
  - OGC report usually confidential and excluded from FOI but agree it can be released post financial close
