2.21	[4.2] Connections to Services: SDS advised that they are not responsible for detailing service connections. They are of the opinion that this is not part of their remit. tie expressed surprise as SDS had said previously that they would be providing details. RD to address this issue for water, gas, and power.	RD
2.22	[4.3] Replacement of Lead Pipes: JL advised that SW insist any lead pipe replacement being carried out at the same time as the diversion and temporary connections would not be allowed. It was noted that this may not be logistically possible on all diversions. JL to re-visit.	JL

3.1	Trial Area: tie advised that they have now received drawings from SDS to include in the Works Order. However, tie have noticed a number of minor errors on the drawings. AMIS confirmed that they would be happy to receive a copy of the drawings marked up with corrections. SDS confirmed that the drawings were Issued for Construction. Works Order Requirements will be issue to AMIS by tie in next day.	Note

	It will mean breaking done the job into more parts and re-visiting sections. This will have an impact on resources, e.g. taking designers off the agreed programme, CAD time to do prints etc.	
	SDS to give full feedback with impact on time and resources on each of the 2 RATS proposals i.e. RATS 1A1 and RATS 1A2.	SDS
4.2	SDS Payment linked to SU Approvals: SDS advised that they have a payment point on gaining SU approval for diversions. They are concerned that the commercial element of gaining approval will delay approval with the resultant knock on impact to their payments. RD to review.	RD
