Please find attached an updated copy of the heads of terms for the MUDFA. Please review and come back to us with any comments.

Please also find attached the first draft of the MOI/PQQ for the MUDFA. We have made a number of comments in the footnotes - please review the document and come back to us with your comments. The financial questions have been taken from the DPOFA PQQ - we suggest that these questions are checked by Stewart and PWC to ensure that we are asking the right questions to ensure the financial robustness of the MUDFA bidders. I have also attached a pdf document which features a few questions from the standard NHS PQQ on health and safety, environmental issues and workforce. Please let me know if you wish to include any of these questions.

From our recent discussions, I have summarised what I consider to be the critical path items for the issue of the MUDFA Contract.

- Development of Specification single specification in multiple parts which comprises requirements on the MUDFA as to the general execution of the works (excavation, surplus material, backfilling, reinstatement, health and safety, plant, signage etc) as well as the specific scoped requirements of the diversions for each utility. This is a major task which will involve compiling the Special Requirements for the Utilities and the obtaining their C4 estimates.
- Development of the design by the SDS Provider how much design needs to be done before issue of the ITT?
- Finalisation of the Utilities Agreements once these are finalised, the appropriate terms can be flowed into the MUDFA.
- Review of Third Party Agreements obligations on access, construction working etc will need to be flowed into the MUDFA. Not all of these Agreements are finalised, so a decision will need to be taken on our approach.
- Pricing/Bills this needs to be determined so as the payment mechanism can be drafted
- TTROs identified on Monday as a high priority item
- Wayleaves work needs to be done on identifying what is required
- Programme works programme and sequencing needs to be developed to link into the above two items

Moving forward, I think that the most difficult issue to sort out will be the management and logistics of the interface between tie/SDS/MUDFA/Utilities with regard to design issues, connection works and completion/commissioning. What is your plan with regard to this issue? How is this to be expressed contractually?
