We are turning around the next draft of the mov tomorrow so will forward that on for discussion when I get it.

Meanwhile the issue causing difficulty is what happens if we fail to agree the second mov re the wider deal.

Infraco think we should terminate as per the Infraco contract which is on terms favourable to them. My view is that hostilities and the existing contract simply resume, a position which nobody wants and which should encourage both parties to agree the wider deal or an amicable separation. The latter would also mean that we would then be negotiating the second mov from a position of equality.

The attached is a rider designed to set this out. It needs further work but I wanted to keep you in the loop.
