INTRODUCTION

The introdu ction of the Edinbur gh trams ystem is an opportunit y to review the spaces and streets alon g the route, identif ying what de fines their character and qualit y, ensurin g these are protected and, where appropriate, enhanced.

the tram must not de fine the character of s paces and streets alon g its route throu gh the cit y of Edinbur gh.

The tram route mu st be a cc ommodated within street s and spaces that are inherentl y 'Edinbur gh' in character.

The 'workbook' format has been develo ped to allow a response to speci fic areas alon g the tram route, coordinatin g with the priorities pro grammed b y TIE and SDS.

each section of the route under goes a process of analysis, with ke y issues identi fied for each. Relevant Edinbur gh guidance is considered, and TIE / SDS proposals tested a gainst both the written and spatial context, and comments / further proposals / guidance provided as re quired.

as the workbook is added to, general principles emer ge which help de fine the overall a pproach to the public realm alon g the route.
