I asked him where he got these allegations from, and he said 'Bilfinger Berger', I asked him 'are you talking to Bilfinger Berger?' he said 'yes, all the time, mostly off the record.'

He also put some suggestions to me that related to my personal credibility, although to be fair he didn't say where these had come from.

As I discussed with Drs Keysberg and Schneppedahl and David Darcy in Germany last week I do not believe this is in the best interests of the project.

Richard, we also discussed the Herald article on Monday and the fact that some members of the public seem to be in possession of information that cannot have been obtained from public sources, which they are then using to feed the press or submit Freedom of Information requests.

Please double check that your teams and advisors are not discussing this project inappropriately.
