Whether we should be telling them that there are things they can't have - eg new road crossings of tram route? On this last point, waterfront told us that if the problem with these was impact on business case, they would meet the extra costs imposed.

We would also want to explain what we need from waterfront ie

We need to go outside limits on their land to be able to build the tram

We would like information from them on utility locations.

Just for clarity - when I suggested that Mike, David and Willie should meet with WEL asap, this was not primarily with the objective of taking forward the ongoing technical discussion - I'm assuming this will continue through the established channels. They will need background on the issues, progress, and the expected timescales for resolution, but the main purpose of this meeting will be to try and alleviate WEL's other concerns, in relation to the business case, commitment to phase 1b, overall programme, etc, and to assure WEL that engagement with them on this level will also be ongoing. Providing assurance on these fronts should help the technical negotiations to proceed as smoothly as possible afterwards. Hope this helps.
