In view of recent comments regarding possible restrictions on council borrowing as part of the governments' overall controls on Public Sector borrowing Donald asked me to prepare a spreadsheet setting out the quantum of possible Council prudential borrowing over the next ten years.

The spreadsheet attached 'outside CIP' sets out projects which you are currently involved in which, as part of the proposed funding arrangements, it is envisaged will require significant elements of prudential borrowing. In order that risks issues to the funding of each projects can be addressed it would be helpful if you could set out other possible funding solutions for your project and the likely financial impact on the council both in capital and revenue terms.

I only require a couple of paragraphs on each project setting out the value of funding that could be obtained from other sources e.g. leasing or pre-sale and the impact on the time line and viability of the project and any other implications.
