At the last Tram IPG meeting we agreed there was a need for a tighter group with less use of deputies given the commercial sensitivity of the issues we are now dealing with. In my view, the revised IPG should include us three, Mark and Jim, plus Marshall as TMO with the additional officers attending to include Alan Coyle (Finance), Andy Conway (transport), Isabell (Comms) and Nick Smith (legal). Alastair MacLean might additionally be required for individual meetings, as the legal issues heat up. Delegated attendees should be no more than one level down i.e Heads of Service; it was daft that we had two tier 4 managers at the March meeting sitting in on such commercially sensitive discussions without any prior context.
