Please find attached CEC reply to risk requirements for contract sign off (Item 5.2(a) on CEC Deliverables list). This specifically deals with the response to Black Flag risks.

I was disappointed with the quality of this information. There are Black Flag risks still with a probability against them for items such as Grant agreement with TS not being closed out as well as the OGC gateway review 3 being incomplete resulting in delay or withdrawal by CEC/TS.

Additionally there has been no quantification of any black flags. This is unacceptable. There may come a point where our directors will want to weigh up the risk of pressing ahead with contract award with certain agreements
