The key issue for us is that tie have always argued that they cannot deliver our standard report to the due deadline (even tho' all other TS promoters have managed this migration) This was only supposed to be an interim covering last October to March but has never been amended and consequently I do not get tie's report until the 2nd morning of the last week of the period - leaving me just 3 days to complete our internal reporting mechanism to TS directors.

If CEC cannot persuade tie to deliver a week earlier, the effective knock-on for yourself means that we can only schedule an effective joint meeting between ourselves on one of the 2 days between our receipt of the report and completion of our internal delivery (normally either the Wednesday or Thursday of that week) Please note that the 4 weekly reports process is a key foundation of the new governance and grant mechanism and continued pressure such as this is not perceived as helpful by my directors.

I am working through your other emails re grant etc and hope to be in a position to respond tomorrow AM.
