Please find attached the Risk Matrix on the Infraco to which I intend to speak on Thursday. This reflects the risk allocation start point in the version of the Contract actually under negotiation by **tie** with the bidders. It cannot, at the moment, capture the focused work in progress emerging from on going bidder engagement as, I believe, has been explained by Lesley.

The Infraco Contract version I understand was released by **tie** to you yesterday is in fact a working draft of the Infraco Contract which contains additional drafting to reflect (a) the detailed alignment of the Infraco and Tramco Contracts (Tramco Contract was issued 6 months prior Infraco ITN): and (b) a variety of commercial adjustments which have been under discussion internally by **tie**. The Risk Matrix does not express the absolute entirely of Infraco contractual obligations transferring risk, but it is very comprehensive.

In terms of evolution of risk allocation under the draft Contract (since ITN), the most expedient means here would be a short note from us summarising the main points. We will produce this early next week, check with **tie** and present on it on Thursday.

Tramco Contract Risk Allocation

We will produce this as soon as possible in co-operation with Lesley, as I understand has been agreed, to reflect most recent bidder negotiations/clarifications. As you may know, our Leeds team has been handling support for **tie** on this element of the transaction and we are working with them on this. I am not certain that time will permit covering this as well at Thursday's session but a start should be possible.

Should any point require further discussion prior to Thursday, please let me know.
