You will have seen my email re MUDFA issues which arose from my meeting with CEC yesterday. Here is a note of the other issues:-

- letter re Developer contributions I understand that the Council has written to you on this and in particular in respect of, in their words, "the dream ticket developer contributions". Can you respond? If you don't have this letter to hand, I will request a copy from Duncan.
- issue re the modelling there is a meeting on Thursday about this with JRC. I will discuss with Al Sim and Stewart and I have copied you in on an email.
- MUDFA the Council said that we were "being mauled" by MUDFA. We're not managing the contract, we not in control, we're reactive etc. I didn't put this in my earlier MUDFA email but you may want to raise it with Susan.
- programme I indicated this was being reviewed could we get something to CEC by the end of next week? This should give us chance to review SDS programme, Infraco priorities and our priorities. I have also emailed Geoff.
- -- tie/CEC communications this is taking too long in the Council's eyes. I was planning on discussing with Suzanne to see if we can streamline this. They are also concerned that despite reaching agreement on the FOISA issue with Alison Bourne she apparently got a plan from SDS (Susan is checking and I don't think she did). I think we need a protocol to deal with this to ensure consistency.
- contact with SDS they have been writing to SDS are statutory undertaker. We need to discuss how best to manage this while still allowing SDS to get consents etc.
- they are keen to have desks at tie possibly two can I arrange with Howard?
- they are keen to have a single point of contact I sent an email to you earlier about this. Can we discuss.
- TRO hearing who is running this? We need to discuss traffic management generally and whether we bring in others we touched on this earlier.
- the structures charette is likely to be on 12, 13 and 14 November.
- CoCP I'm going to go ahead and arrange a workshop on this to pick up the Council's issues. I will arrange this for end of November as this is not a priority.
