1) draft note to ministers has gone to Bill as discussed - it covers the 3 key issues we need decisions on to

close out negotiations on the £500m and concessionary fares, and whether we need go to cabinet. If the answer is no to the latter we may be better placed to meet CEC's timetable on decisions regarding Financial close
