Further to your request this AM for SDS to issue the dwg files prepared under the MUDFA contract, I have to advise that SDS cannot issue these drawings at this time, as we continue to pursue settlement with tie for the work carried out in producing these items.

There has been an ongoing, unresolved dialogue for several months, with little acknowledgement from tie that the SDS application is being considered.

Without resolution of the commercial issue specific to these drawings, SDS are not able to provide the baseline information you seek.

I trust you understand our position with regard to this specific matter.

We remain fully committed to working with Infracore and the Client to minimise the risk to the project of Utility conflict between Haymarket and York Place, and are progressing the works instructed under PWtNC 13 - Redesign to avoid Utilities.
