BSC has already told us this is a Change through raising INTC 549. We need to enclose the tie Notice of Change now in accordance with the contract so the second sentence of the last paragraph needs to stay.

The purpose of the first sentence of the last paragraph is to limit the precedent value of this letter. BSC persistently argues that CEC is late in raising an issue and so it is a change. Our general position is that it is for BSC to get it right and it doesn't matter when CEC notices that it hasn't.
