Dear all, thanks for your time yesterday.

A couple of follow up points.

Can I suggest that Stewart McGarrity takes the role of Legal manager and that any requests for legal advice will be co-ordinated through Stewart, (although Tony, David Mackay and I will also be empowered to instruct legal work). I will push very hard with CEC to ensure that any requests they have are filtered through Stewart to avoid some of the 'mad rush' of requests currently coming through.

Separately the board feel strongly that launching an action to clarify the role of schedule 4 in the context of the 'commercially absurd' argument (as we discussed yesterday) is something that we should push asap. In the expectation that such an action will take many (8?) months, we do not expect an answer any time soon, but launching the action should cause some doubt in the minds of BSC.
