I sense that there is a dispute arising around the way in which BB prepared its pricing and its Pricing Assumptions. We have been supporting Dennis and Steven on this and I have now -with Dennis's instruction - briefed on of our litigation colleagues. We will not do any serious engagement on this without discussion and instruction but if there is a DRP process this is likely to move quickly and tie need to be well prepared.

A very critical issue will be: what drawings and design data BBS were given access to (and were using prior to the 25th November 2008: "Base Date Design Information") - the date used as a freeze (given the on-going work at that time by SDS) in terms of the maturity of drawings being used by BBS to fix their pricing and set up their pricing assumptions - which have been contractualised. I understand that this is being chased down at the moment. Prior to and at Close, we were waiting to be given that information set - but it did not eventuate in time -so that BB may seek to say that their INfraco Proposal drawings are the only drawings that should be recognised. This is a weak position but the absence of precision on what constitutes Base Date Design Information is not helpful.
