	 Proposed consents programme risk allocation as set out in the Consents paper prepared by GG and dated 10th January 2007 BBS stated that they qualified their bid such that they would not take any risk in respect of the SDS programme (Post Meeting Note – No such Qualification found) BBS want stronger control and incentivisation of the SDS performance BBS want tie to take risk on SDS programme performance. BBS expressed concern that SDS's programme is slipping Believe that SDS contract requires due skill and care only and that they believed time was not of the essence under that contract.

	 All parties agreed that a programme for delivery of CEC technical and prior approval consents will be agreed and aligned with the BBS construction programme as agreed under the novation plan. Commecial consideration in respect of incentivisation and any price adjustment is to be settled separately. AF explained the basis of SDS's time based obligations onder the SDS contract. BBS to consider and respond by 4pm on 16/1/08 Additional design control measures – BBS proposal to be provided by 5pm 16/1/08. GG stated that prepared to listen to the proposal but that does not mean acceptance of the principle.
