Str 21E - Water of Leith Bridge - substructure DD submitted to tie 08 October 07. Issue of superstructure DD immanent on programme.
Str 22 - Balgreen Road Bridge - available info provided to tie on info drop of 20 November 07.
Str 23 - Carrick Knowe Bridge - Work in Progress (WIP) info provided to tie on info drop of 20 November 07.
Str 24 - Existing Saughton Road Bridge - no works required. Bridge assessment submitted to tie on 18 April 07.
Str 25 - Existing Broomehouse Road Bridge - no works required. Bridge assessment submitted to tie on 18 April 07.
Str 26 - South Gyle Access Bridge - WIP info provided to tie on info drop of 20 November 07.
Str 28 - A8 Underpass - WIP info provided to tie on info drop of 23 November 07.
Str 29 - Gogarburn Bridge - WIP info provided to tie on info drop of 20 November 07.

Roads information (WIP) was provided to BBS - Section 1A at the Roads meeting initially, then formally transmitted to tie on 20 November info drop, including draft work at Lindsay Road. Section 1C was transmitted on 23 November WIP drop. Otherwise, all other Detailed Design submittals are with tie as deliverables.

SDS have previously advised that we are not providing AutoCAD files on this draft information, and this has been discussed in detail with tie previously.

WIP MX information for Roads and Track was provided to tie on 20 November information drop. MX for available earthworks was provided at 23 November information drop. The caveats to this were clearly outlined in the respective letters for each.

I trust that this confirms that SDS has previously provided the available information as discussed.

Can you confirm whether this is yet been passed to document control?

"BBS received a CD on the 23/11/07 that was to contain all the SDS work in progress that would enable BBS produce a firm price. There are some new documents contained on the CD however most are all ready on the data room, for example we do not have detailed info for structures S21E S22 S23 S24 S25 S26 S28 S29"

- * roads design as last update produced for comment at Roads Design Working Group
- * Both above in Pdf and Autocad
- * MX earthworks and track strings
