Sorry to trouble you on your day away from Edinburgh, but I wonder if you could review the attached and then perhaps we could talk when you are next in the office. As we discussed yesterday, the approach taken to valuing deliverables is looking inappropriate as we increase the total number of packages. The analysis for the current application for payment shows that the impact of revaluation based on 325 vs. the baseline 284 is a reduction in payment of ~£460k. If we could review and if it were possible to revise the payment certified prior to payment this time that would be much appreciated
