Yesterday I met with the CEC team heading up the redevelopment of St Andrew Square. They have requested technical changes to the tramway to facilitate the redevelopment, in particular shifting the tram alignment (including the tramstop) by approximately half a metre east to allow for a 4.35m pavement around the square (gardens).

I understand from Scott that the tram alignment and roads has already gone through the RDWG and is agreed. Thus this would have to be taken back and raised as a Change.

I did not manage to get hold of Andy Conway directly before he went on leave but notified him by email as he was not present at the meeting.

SDS are requesting direction from tie on this issue as it is a Change to the design and has cost implications.
