Infraco Risk Update

Risk reviews were carried out in the period with the PMs for Signalling, Communication and Control, Princes Street, Roads and Drainage, Structures, Network Rail, the Depot and Section 1A. All treatment plans were reviewed and updated. The risks below are those high-level risks identified by the Infraco Director as currently facing the Infraco team. The risk relating to a commercial dispute has now occurred and is being controlled by **tie** management with a number of issues currently going through the Dispute Resolution Process (DRP) and several others being prepared to enter the DRP process. A review of the Infraco risk allocation (QRA) is underway and has progressed in Period 8 with the Commercial Manager, Risk Manager and Deputy Finance Director. A meeting with the appropriate directors to review the latest cost forecast plus risk allowance is arranged for early period 9.
