Action herewith passed to Klaus as triggered from your e-mail but please don't expect miracles until we come back after New Year...

I.m.h.o. we should analyze the "real" best case/worst case project cases, and, on the main line. Perhaps all the combination of cases described by John Dolan (e.g. combination of X type of rail with Y type of crossing) do not exist in the project. We also might consider submitting a less detailed analysis for S&C's in the Depot area, where the hazards involved (thanks to traffic at very low speed, fully empty vehicle, and very low mileage / wear and tear) are significantly lower.

Also many questions are related to the construction Method Statement and will be responded then. With all due respect, Schedule Part 14 of the contract does not force us to submit the Method Statements before closing design nor procurement, but just a certain prudent time before site works; and we are talking of 6 months manufacturing lead times here, AFTER design concluded and approved! Our main concern is truly to START manufacturing. All installation questions being legitimate, there should not be any impediment to approve designs as "Level B" and allow us to start manufacturing.
