Matters are moving along on a number of fronts.

I have written to Sharon Fitzgerald as instructed and await her response.

The various risk concerns are being addressed ahead of the Council report with Donald and Andrew to establish whether that report should actually proceed on 20 December, and in what format, given the various unresolved matters.
