Dear Richard

You will recall that following the issue of Lord Dervaird's decision on 8 August 2010, I set out my immediate analysis of that decision in an e-mail of the same date. In my note of the following day, I addressed what I considered to be the scope of Lord Dervaird's decision, and specifically what it did *not* deal with. I also set out my thoughts on the way forward.

For convenience, I attach a copy of my e-mail and note. These documents were passed to Richard Keen QC, together with the decision itself, for his advice. A conference call to discuss the decision was held between Richard Keen and Simona Williamson on 19 August 2010 during my absence on annual leave. A note was prepared of that call and passed to Richard Keen for his approval.

Subsequently, I discussed with Richard Keen the linkage between clause 34.3 and clause 80 (a point flagged up by Lord Dervaird in his decision), and also the significance of clause 80.20.

I now attach Richard Keen's Opinion on these issues, together with the note of the conference call of 19 August.
