Following calls from Graeme Bissett and Andrew Fitchie DLA tonight's meeting will brief CEC on present position. Essentially position as you advised. Informal mediation last week. DLA instructed to complete their review of "option 1" ie more aggressive use of contract and contractual remedies including DRP, consideration of mechanisms re visibility of contingent liability and potential consideration of remedies with PC Guarantee and Performance Bond and opportunities and risks of considering these mechanisms. The potential 12 parts of contractual works is understood to be whilst BB remain a partner and if consent was not reached, very likely liability in damages to them but there is a possibility of negotiation in relation to DRP.

DLA have not been again asked to consider if material or fundamental breach to give a view on BB's removal . Andrew's very informal view on the telephone is that DLA have not yet been given all the correspondence and diligence they would require to do before assessing but essentially there is no legal view on low or reasonable risk as there is no view yet.

I will explore all further at today's meeting and update again before your Wednesday meeting.


