On Friday we took one of our (many) outstanding issues with the consortium to mediation. This mediation resulted in agreement, with both parties declaring they are happy with the outcome. As with all dispute resolution compromise was required on all sides.

The fact that this mediation took place and was successful is in the public domain, but the contents of the resulting MoU are not. It will of course be subject to FOISA

The issue in dispute is a complex technical one, not necessarily easy (but by no means impossible) to explain to lay people. It has connections with the issue on Princes Street and might raise some other questions. I will send you a copy of the signed MoU
