Following our conversation last week I have completed an analysis of BSC related (Infraco) changes approved through the DAR **tie** change process (see attached).

In summary, the analysis has raised a number of concerns with regards to Delegated Authority compliance. In particular, tie have issued over £8.8m of changes to BSC which have not yet been formally approved through our change process (£4.9m with no change order raised, and a further £3.9m classified as 'on-hold). Furthermore, we have paid/ Certified £2.8m against change items not processed through the change panel on top of the £7.2m certified through the Princes Street Supplemental agreement.
