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Summary

This report sets out the current issues in relation to the Scottish Water interface on the Edinburgh Tram project. The report sets out the current status of each issue and the position proposed by CEC. There are currently forty five issues in *Table 1 – Issues List* below.

SW and CEC acknowledged at a meeting on 14th May 2013 that a process was required to resolve the remaining outstanding issues. The meeting agreed a process to crystallise the areas of disagreement and promote resolution through a meeting of the principals from SW, CEC and Transport Scotland. The agreed resolution process was as follows:

- All parties to agree the areas of dispute.
- Position papers to be issued within 21 days.
- Parties to respond to the position papers within 14 days.
- Principals to meet within 7 days of the responses being received.

SW and CEC subsequently met on 29th May 2013 to discuss the issues of legal and contractual dispute. These issues were agreed on 31st May 2013. As a result of this agreement the following timescales have been established:

- Position papers to be issued on 21st June 2013
- Responses to position papers to be provided by 5th July 2013
- Principals meeting to take place by 12th July 2013

On 12th June CEC notified SW that the issues to be resolved would be widened to include areas of technical difference. As a result this report provides details of the final position promoted by CEC with respect to the outstanding technical matters.

Please note the positions established by CEC are based on the information made available by tie to CEC.
