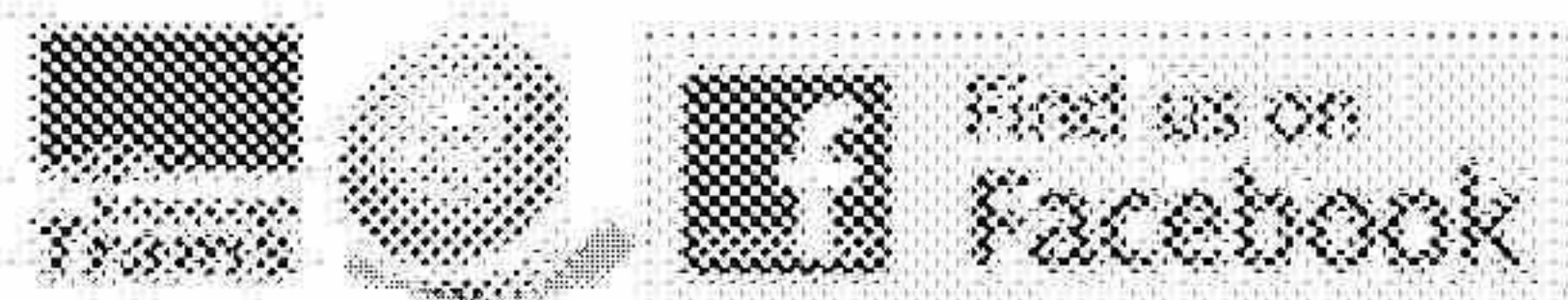

The “As-built” data was collated on a periodic basis by the tie planner in the MUDFA office. This would be from data reported by Carillion and confirmed by our Project Managers.  
In the example you have provided, we would have reported this diversion as being completed during period 07 2008-09 with Carillion reporting it during Period 08 2008-09. I would suggest that the Carillion report is probably 1 period adrift but that is something you would have to get Graeme Barclay or John Casserly to concur with.
