Following your telephone message I have further amended the draft Change mechanism at Clause 80.20.4 to cover :

1. Omission of the requirement to produce an Estimate within 20 working days which will allow us to agree a suitable number of days for each proposed change (see note 6 of my email on 28th Nov).
2. To add in the requirement to demonstrate full effect of programme when assessed with other relevant changes/instructions within 40 business days and for tie to respond within 20 business days. This deals with the Steve Sharp note that you handed to me however I have amended the timescales which I think are more appropriate.

I trust that this is the only real issue that exists between us from the previous draft sent on Monday and that this revised draft is acceptable.
