Para 2.1 - SEStran cannot "stipulate" what happens in this Council area.

If the proposed "minimum requirements to be applied within the SEStran area" are already met by those Councils who have their own Strategies, I have no objection to that phrase. If not, I do.

If you intend individual Councils to be able to adopt the BPIS they would have to follow statutory procedures and therefore when you advertise the draft I think you would have to have their names on the advert in addition to SEStran (or with SEStran as agent) – otherwise they would have to readvertise in their own right. As this Council has a BPIS, please do not include our name in the advert.

Para 3.3 – please delete last sentence. If Falkirk's BPIS is not the same as SEStrans's, this would imply that we should go back to Committee and through the statutory processes all over again. As I understand it, such duplication of effort was never intended.
