- Paragraph 20 delete and replace with "The Council shall comply with Transport Scotland's standard project reporting procedure. The standard project report templates are to be completed on a 4-weekly basis and these will form the Council's progress report to Transport Scotland. The report is to be forwarded to Transport Scotland by no later than 12 noon on the Friday of 'Week 1' in the cycle for the preceding four-week period. The latest report is to form the agenda for a formal meeting of Transport Scotland and Council officials, this meeting is to be convened within the first half of 'Week 2' of the cycle."

Acceptance of this offer must include an updated capital spending plan for the remainder of the current financial year in relation to the grant being offered. The grant is to be drawn down against this plan.
